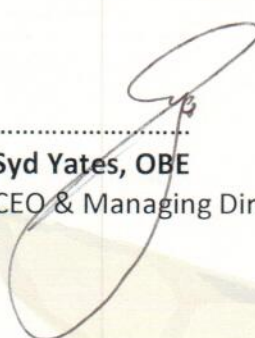

APPENDIX 4B STATEMENT

FOR THE SIX MONTHS ENDED 30 JUNE 2017

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INTERIM RESULTS FOR ANNOUNCEMENT TO THE MARKET 6 MONTHS ENDING 30 JUNE 2017

The reporting period is the year ended 30 June 2017 with the corresponding prior period being the year ended 30 June 2016.

Highlights

Kina Asset Management Ltd (KAML) recorded a NPAT of K5.0m up 48.24% for the year ending 30 June 2017 compared to the previous corresponding period.

The half year delivered a strong investment performance for shareholders with the company's portfolio generating an investment return of 9.5%.

Main contributors to the result were a valuation gain of K3.4m resulting from a strong performance of the share prices of CSL Limited (CSL) and Bank South Pacific (BSP) which rose by 37.5% and 6.0% respectively over the period

Dividend and interest income were also strong contributors to the Fund with dividends and interest income totalling K2.3 million. The depreciation of the Kina against the Australian dollar by 6.1% over the period also contributed to the growth in the value of the Fund, with currency gains adding K2.0 million.

Asset allocation at year end was 41.6% invested in domestic stocks, cash and fixed income; and 58.4% invested in international stocks and cash.

Key portfolio holdings at year end were BSP at 21.5% of the Fund, Vanguard International at 11.7%, Oil Search Limited at 7.6% and Mirvac Group at 5.3%.

The Fund's key investment sectors of domestic and international equities outperformed their respective benchmarks over the year.

Net tangible asset backing per share as at 30 June 2017 was K1.26 (K1.14) (unaudited and pre dividend).

Domestic Investments

- Bank South Pacific (BSP) again provided healthy returns with a 14.8% total return. This was attributed in large part to the 6.0% increase in share price as well as a dividend of 79 toea which was paid during the first 6 months. BSP currently provides an annual dividend yield of 9.8% which represents excellent ongoing income for the Fund and its shareholders. BSP is the largest investment position in the Fund representing 21.5% of the portfolio and in the view of the Manager remains a strong investment for KAML's investors.

International Investments

- CSL was the best stock performer in the international portfolio generating a total return of 38.3% during the first 6 months of the year, continuing its solid performance from prior periods.
- Mirvac (MGR) was also a top performer during the first 6 months with a total return of 14.8%. As a property owner and developer the company has continued to reap the benefits of a strong property market in Australia.



Outlook

The first 6 months of the financial year has started well for the company and its investors. Global markets remain strong, underwritten by high levels of liquidity, ongoing low interest rates and low inflation and an earnings season in the United States that was well ahead of expectations. Domestically the economy remains under pressure however KAML's investments are largely in sectors not heavily exposed to domestic consumption.

We remain cautious for the balance of the year as markets are generally highly valued and global political risk remains a threat to markets.

KAML retains a solid liquidity position which is held offshore. This will be of benefit as opportunities arise, and also given our view that the Kina (PGK) will further weaken over the balance of this year.

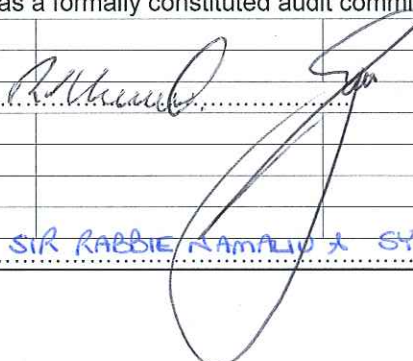
